

Special terms for the Daylesford and Beaufort Timber Auction:

1. Meet all minimum requirements (see table below)
2. Full payment prior to collection
3. If truck scales are not present, Buyer must work with DEECA to determine safe loading level of the vehicle, this may be achieved by:
 - Use of appropriate conversion factor and/ or,
 - Use a public weighbridge.
4. Submit Buyer Registration Form (including mandatory acknowledgement of ability to comply with all requirements).
 - Completed form must be received to be granted access to auction platform.
5. Timeline for collection
 - Collection of by-product must be arranged with DEECA and completed prior to 23/10/2026 unless otherwise agreed in writing or precluded due to weather/ site conditions. Failure to do so may lead to forfeiture of any uncollected by-product and invoicing for costs to remove the uncollected portion.

Minimum requirements:

Category	Requirement
Insurance	• Public Liability ◦ Sole Trader minimum coverage of \$10,000,000. ◦ Company minimum coverage of \$20,000,000. • WorkCover (if applicable) • Vehicles: 3rd party (minimum) • Other (specify)
Haulage	All vehicles (including trailers etc.) must be: • Registered and roadworthy • Fitted with calibrated scales (log trucks/ tippers) • Comply with the <i>Log Haulage Industry Code of Practice</i> or for other configurations, compliant with the <i>By-Products Haulage Guidelines</i>
Unloading	Unloading facilities to receive by-product: • Machinery, site and procedures meet industry safety standards and be compliant with OHS law.
Safe work system compliance	Appropriate safe systems of work are in place (or able to be enacted) for all activities associated with the collection, transport and unloading of by-product.
Ability to pay	Able to pay 100% of the purchase price prior to collection of by-product (<i>unless otherwise stipulated in the terms of the Auction or individual lot</i>)
